Dr. Brian MacKie, DVM, DACVIM (Cardiology) received his Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree from Washington State University in 2005. Following graduation, he completed a one-year rotating internship in small animal medicine and surgery at VCA Sacramento Animal Medical Group in Sacramento, California. After his internship, he moved to the University of Wisconsin - Madison to complete his residency training in Cardiology from 2006-2009. Dr. MacKie practices at VCA Sacramento Veterinary Referral Center.

Dr. MacKie's talk will cover the structure and function of the heart. He will then discuss those heart diseases most commonly seen in the St. Bernard dog. This discussion will cover the disease process in the heart, the symptoms observed in the dog, the diagnostics that are required to accurately diagnose the disease, the treatments available, and the long-term prognosis. This education event will last approximately 90 minutes.
